## **DETAILS:**

Here is a fun way to make recycled paper at home!

YOU'LL NEED:

Newspaper

Large Pan

Flat Board

Blender

Water

Screen

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Tear up two sheets of newspaper into small pieces.
- 2. Put the pieces in a blender with 4 cups of water. (Have an adult help with the blender)
- 3. Place the screen in the pan and cover it with water. Put the newspaper mixture, called pulp, on the screen. Spread the pulp evenly across the screen.
- 4. Remove the screen with the pulp on top from the water-filled pan, letting the water drip off first. Place the screen and pulp inside a section of newspaper.
- 5. Lay the flat board on top of the screen and squeeze the water out of the paper.
- 6. Carefully remove the screen from the layer of pulp. Let the pulp dry.
- 7. Once fully dried, paint your version of Mother Earth on your new recycled paper!

## DIY your Screen.

Find an old picture frame, and find nylons, stockings or even a scrap of any mesh fabric that doesn't break easily. Place the Fabric tight against the picture frame and staple together very tight.
